What \$500 Writing Contest Scholarship Award

Sponsored by Greater Kenosha Community Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs Awareness Committee, Kenosha, WI. The recipient will be awarded a \$500 scholarship.

Who is Eligible Any senior high school student planning to enroll in a post high school educational program (college, vocational/technical school, etc.) after high school graduation.

How to Enter Author a personal narrative highlighting your involvement with Alcohol, Tobacco, or Drug prevention education giving a reflection of your own experience within the group. For example, involvement in S.A.D.D, Tobacco Truth Tour, Concerned Citizens Coalition Teen Task Force, Ninth Grade Transitional Coaches Program, Peer Helpers, FACT, etc.

Composition entries are to be double-spaced and typed. Student name, age, grade, and school are to be recorded on the upper right hand corner of the composition.

Applicants are required to get a letter of support from a staff member or organization they are involved with.
