Graduates who have earned academic distinction earning four AP credits or graduates who are members of our National Honor Society will be wearing an honor cord. The cords will be provided by LakeView, for use during the ceremony and collected afterwards. If your child qualifies and you would like to purchase an honor cord as a keepsake they are available in the office for \$10.

Diplomas will be picked up after the ceremony in the gathering space outside the auditorium.

Admission tickets are not required for the ceremony. If a graduation cap and gown has not been purchased, please do so immediately at jostens.com. They may also be purchased in the school office for \$49.00 (cash only).

We will include a slideshow during our ceremony of our graduates. Please submit two pictures of your child. A senior portrait and a toddler picture are preferred. Pictures can be professional or amateur in nature. We strongly recommend you select images that focus solely on your child because they are displayed for only a brief period, group photos don't have the same impact as solo shots.
