Only grade 11 students are to report for all high schools on both Feb. 27 and 28. Specific information for start and dismissal times will be communicated at the district and school level.

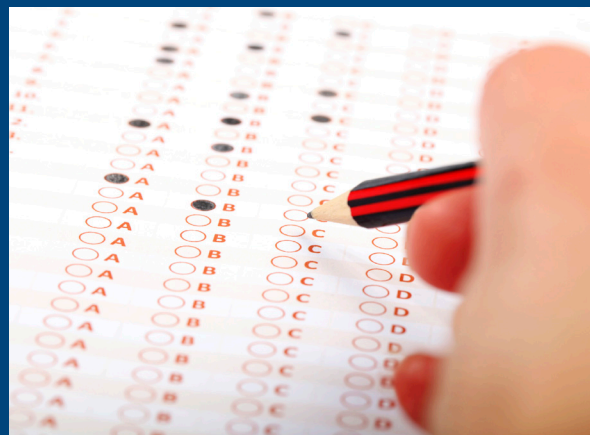

What to bring on testing days:

- Picture Identification (school ID or driver's license)
- Two #2 pencils with erasers (not mechanical)
- Calculator (personal calculators must be pre-approved)
- Snack (during break only)

What **NOT** to bring on testing days:

- Cell phones or other electronic devices
- Watches
- Scratch paper
- Notes
- Reading Materials



Cost:

No cost to parents or students

ACT with Writing scores can be used by students for college enrollment, scholarships and NCAA eligibility requirements. Scores can be reportable to up to four colleges of student's choice. These colleges must be self-identified on the ACT answer sheet. Scores will also be mailed directly to the home address indicated on the ACT answer sheet 4-6 weeks after testing.

ACT WorkKeys allows students to earn a National College Readiness Certificate (NCRC) that is recognized nationally by business and industry. Depending on level of scores, Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Certificates may be awarded.
