### ***Student Dress Code:***

With the new school year quickly approaching you may be going out to purchase new clothes for your child(ren), and I would like to share with you an issue of safety that has to do with footwear. Virtually every student at LakeView takes technology education classes in labs covered by OSHA rules and regulations, and open toed shoes are not allowed in the labs. This must be adhered to for safety reasons. Students may not wear open toe shoes in the lab. Your support and cooperation is greatly appreciated. The full Board of Education Rule 5431-Student Dress Code is included in this newsletter.

### ***County H & Bain Station Road Roundabout Project:***

Reconstruction of the intersection of County H and Bain Station Road has begun with a scheduled completion of late Fall 2017. The intersection is closed to thru traffic, and will remain closed throughout the duration of the project. If you are travelling from the north to LakeView, please take Highway 31 to 95<sup>th</sup> Street or the East Frontage Road to Highway 165 to Highway H. Traffic on 95<sup>th</sup> Street will be extremely busy, please drive safe and allow extra time to get to school on time.

### ***Online Enrollment:***

KUSD will again be requiring online enrollment of all students using the Infinite Campus Portal. The Portal is open to enroll your students. Please visit the KUSD homepage: <http://kusd.edu> and click on the "Families" tab and begin the registration process. **Infinite Campus in only supported with Google Chrome and Firefox browsers. It is very important to allow pop-ups to successfully complete your registration.** Your application is not complete until you click the **RED SUBMIT BUTTON**.

### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

Please have on hand the following information before you begin the online registration process:

- Household information – address and phone numbers
- Parent/guardian information – email address, birthdates, work and cell phone numbers
- Student information – demographic and health/medical information (including physician information)
- Emergency contact information – remember to use full name(s) and phone numbers
- If you have had a change of address, you will need to upload proof of residency while you are completing your online enrollment. Acceptable forms of proof of residency are:
  - Current WE Energies bill
  - Current title/mortgage information
  - Current lease agreement

### **Save yourself valuable time**

- It is highly recommended that you complete the online enrollment and pay your fees online **before** you come to registration. This will **SIGNIFICANTLY** cut down on your wait time at registration. If possible, please print a copy of your payment receipt and bring it with you to registration to expedite the check-in process.
- Computer stations will be available during onsite registration for parents that still need to complete the online enrollment expectation.

### ***Student Fees:***

Due to limited parking spaces available, parking permits will be available for purchase at registration by **Seniors and Juniors only** for \$50.00. To purchase a parking permit, the parking registration form included in this newsletter must be completed (both sides) and signed by both student and parent. Please bring the form along with payment to registration to purchase a 2017-2018 permit. The student transportation agreement covers a student driving to/from other school district events.

At registration, student schedules and transportation information will be handed out. Students that purchased a 2016/2017 LakeView yearbook will be able to pick up their yearbook.

Enclosed is a computer damage and vandalism policy form for all LakeView students and their parent/guardian to sign. Please bring the completed form to registration. If you have questions, please call the office at 359-8155.

### ***Immunization Law Requirements:***

Please ensure that your child(ren) is in compliance with the enclosed Student Immunization Law Age/Grade Requirements for the 2017-18 School Year.

### ***Medication Authorization Form:***

A medication authorization form is enclosed *if needed*. This form must be brought to the office by a parent with necessary medication(s) on the first day medication(s) needs to be administered. Medications can only be brought to school by a parent/guardian, not a student, this includes over-the-counter medications as well. All medication will be kept in the office. Prescription medication also requires a health care provider signature. Medications ordered to be taken daily in the morning are to be given at home before coming to school.

### ***Gear-Up:***

All incoming freshmen are welcome to attend a half-day gear-up session on August 21<sup>st</sup>. You will have the opportunity to meet some of your new classmates, learn a little more about LakeView, and have some fun. Please go to the LakeView website to sign up (<http://lakeview.kusd.edu/>).

### ***First Day of School:***

School begins at 7:19 a.m. on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup> for **all students**. There will not be classes at Harborside on September 5<sup>th</sup>. If your child has classes at Harborside, she/he can be picked up at LakeView at 12:55 p.m.

### ***School Pictures:***

Pictures will be taken Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:30 a.m. Picture packets will be available at registration and in the office.

### ***School ID's:***

ALL students are required to have a school ID while at school. ID's will be handed-out September 6<sup>th</sup> when students have their school picture taken. Replacement IDs will be available to purchase for \$1.50 in the office in October.

### ***School Lunches:***

Money can be deposited in advance, and students can withdraw lunch purchases from their account. Check and cash deposits can be made into lunch accounts during registration. If you wish to deposit money online in your child's school food account, please go to: [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com). When purchasing a lunch, students enter their student ID number at the register. All students that received free or reduced lunches during the 2016/2017 school year will continue to receive lunch until the beginning of October, or until your new application has been processed. New forms will be mailed to students that previously qualified for free/reduced lunches.

### ***Student Personal Computer Policy:***

Students planning to use personal laptops at LakeView for the 2017-2018 school year will need to have it approved first. (Please note that approvals from last year do not qualify your device for the current school year.) You must submit a permission form signed by your parent/guardian and present your device for recording and tagging. Student devices **are not allowed** on the wireless network. Please see Adam in Room 101 for more information.

**Calendar:**

Please review the following calendar for important dates. Students who take classes at Harborside will have a number of days that there are no classes at Harborside for LakeView students. On those days, students are welcome to stay at LakeView and attend AAA for periods 7&8, or be picked-up by a parent after period 6.

**Sophomore Class Ring Presentation:**
