Dear Parents and Guardians of LakeView Class of 2018,

As we near the end of first semester and graduation approaches, it is time for senior portraits to be taken and turned in. In order to include your child's senior portrait in the 2017 - 2018 LakeView Yearbook, a digital copy must be turned in before the end of the school day Tuesday, April 10th, 2018. Digital copies may be uploaded to ReplayIt.com, shared with Mrs. Overocker at joverock@teachers.kusd.edu, or turned in via a memory card, disc, or usb drive to Mrs. Overocker or the main office.

Portraits must meet the following requirements:

- The digital image must be taken with a 10 megapixel camera or higher.
- The image must be at least 1600x2100 pixels.
- **No cell phone pictures.**
- The photograph must be vertical. (No horizontal photographs will be used on the senior portraits page.)
- The portrait must be a waist up, bust shot, or close up. (No full length standing photographs.)
- Clothing worn in the portrait must follow the school dress code.
- Background and props used in the portrait must be school appropriate.

Although we recommend using a professional photographer, students may have their portraits taken anywhere and by any photographer. If your child has already had senior portraits taken, please have the studio contact Mrs. Overocker directly.
